The **WATER** program offers a variety of activities to teach our students, about one of the most critical issues - water.

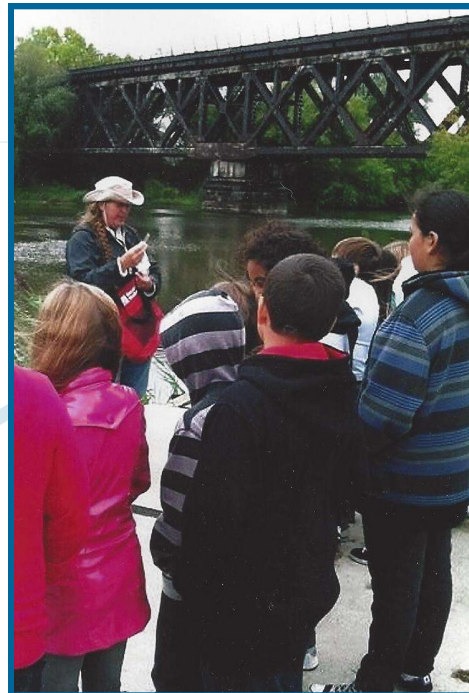


Students have a unique opportunity to conduct scientific tests to determine the water quality of Lake Michigan and the Root River.
